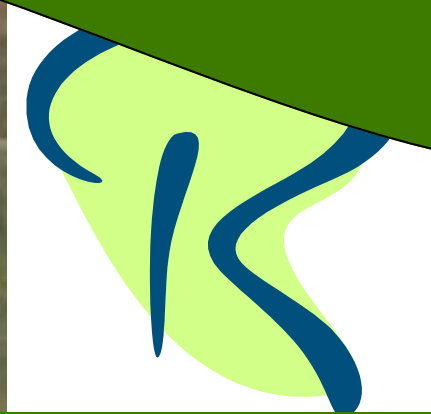

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A MESSAGE FROM THE TURF CARE CENTRE...

The heat has finally arrived and the course is improving daily. We have completed another round of seeding on the old and damaged greens. At this point germination will happen in days, and the Poa is filling in quickly. We have recently cored and seeded the 6th green. These holes are mostly full of sand, and will recover in less than a week. We will continue to needle tine and seed without disruption to play. We have lowered the height of cut on greens and will do so again next week as we reach the summer height of cut and green speed. This is a week or so later than usual due to early season conditions on greens. We will be rolling greens Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday as much as possible.

I would like to take this time to thank my hard working staff for their efforts this spring. It is no small undertaking to manage the season and the spring with the number of staff we employ. This is made much more difficult when much of our time is spent on greens recovery. We are finally emerging from that damage and the small details of the course that were neglected. All bunkers have been edged this week, and weeds have been sprayed. We are still working on the trimming around trees and tree lines. We will be adding four staff in the next few weeks to reach our seasonal operating capacity.

The 15th hole is fully in play including the greens expansion. We are still in the process of training down the turf in the fairway, and on the green surround, including the collar. We plan on building the walking bridge on the weekend of June 10th. This will allow for easy access across the creek to retrieve your ball or to play back on to the golf hole.

Lastly we are beginning a plan to improve the range, practice area, and chipping green. We will be mowing the target greens, the rear tee, and chipping green surrounds shorter and more often. The approach to the chipping green will expand and a fairway height area will be added to replicate course conditions. The high tee in the back will be lowered, and a growth regulator will be used in all areas to slow growth and improve consistency. It will take some time for it to look and play correctly. One last reminder that the Artificial Mats are used on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Please only move on to the grass to tee up your driver on those days. This will help with wear of the grass tee and give time for the seed to germinate and fill in.
