A MESSAGE FROM THE TURF CARE TEAM...

It has been a challenging start to the 2018 golf season. We have experienced some timely rains lately which has greened the course up nicely. Prior to that it was extremely dry, just as it was much of last year. The high spots, and collars still have a way to go but have begun to bounce back. We will be aerating and seeding some of them next week. Most of the greens are filling in due to the seeding we have done, as well as Poa activating and beginning to spread. The front of 2, and the side of 9 will get another round of seeding.

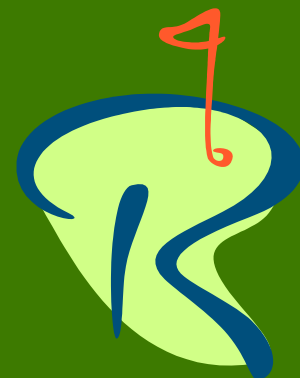
At this point we do not plan to start plugging, but rather be patient with the work we have done. The sixth green is in poor condition and has been slower to recover. It faces many challenges such as poor soil, poor turf, no drainage, heavy traffic due to size, few pin placements, poor entry/exit areas, and other issues. We have just finished coring, and seeding it again today. Unfortunately, we will not be doing anything significant regarding design and reconstruction for at least five years.

As for the rest of the golf course it is in excellent condition. The greens, tees, and fairways are all solid with a few small areas in need of some Poa healing. As usual this time of year those beautiful yellow flowers pop up on the course. We have sprayed once and will again in the coming weeks. It is also the time of year when grass is growing in areas we don't want, and will not grow in areas we do want. The bunkers have been serviced once but there is more work remaining. There is also long grass around tees, trees and bush lines. It is difficult to keep up prior to the summer student's arrival. It will all come together in the next few weeks.

The greens are beginning to roll true and nearing summer speeds. We have still been verticutting and topdressing weekly. We will be lowering the height of cut this week to achieve summer speeds and smoothness.

We have finally cut up, and chipped all the branches and logs on the golf course from the winter removal of dead, standing trees. We will continue that work this fall since we will not be busy managing the renovation of the 18th hole. We recently lost the large oak behind the 15th green which was hit by lightning last year.

You may have noticed the second cut we have added this year. This consists of two passes on the edge of all par fours and fives at a height of cut between fairway and rough height. This should alleviate a heavy, and unfair lie a few yards off the fairway.



We have also topped up all the sand drains from last year for the second time this year. They should start to heal together, but please take free relief in the meantime. We have added green sand and seed to our divot program this year. There are divot containers at each tee and larger fill stations at the 4th, 8th, and 10th tee where golfers can fill their sand containers. We thank you for your participation in keeping our course clean and green.
